Crossroads Annual Report 2019-2020

Dear Friends,

Wow—last school year certainly didn't end the way any of us expected!!

COVID-19 sent students and teachers home, to struggle with online learning. But despite this, teachers worked hard to maintain relationships remotely, via phone calls, texts, Zoom conferences, and even porch visits. In the end, two students graduated, with a “socially-distanced” car parade ceremony, and an additional 37 students in 6th through 12th grades moved forward in their education.

In 2010, Crossroads School started with four 6th and 7th graders, one teacher, and a dream to provide highly relational, individualized, hands-on education for struggling students. Last year and every year since we began, we have seen lives changed every day.

Last year, thanks to the generosity of FaithPoint Church, we were able to better accommodate our growth by moving to a new, larger space that was designed for a school. . . and unbeknownst to all of us, that would become critical this fall as we opened our doors to in-person, socially-distanced education that would have been challenging in our previous smaller location!

2020 is the 10th anniversary of Crossroads School. To celebrate, we focused on seeking out alumni stories, and discovering where a Crossroads education has taken our 27 graduates. Currently, they are a full-time welder in South Dakota; a business student at Kansas University; a soldier in the infantry at the Pentagon; a nursing graduate from Simpson University; an instrument-rated pilot; a veterinary student at BYU-Idaho; a new mother; a prospective marine; a self-employed artist; a certified preschool teacher; an auto mechanic; and more.

In the 2020-21 school year, despite the pandemic, we are currently serving 32 students. Crossroads continues to take positive steps as we grow, and I am in awe of the multiple ways we get to see God's hand move, not only in the lives of students but in the lives of staff and partners like you, as well!

Thank you for being part of the Crossroads team. Together we are changing our world—one life at a time!




THE MISSION OF CROSSROADS


2019-2020 Fiscal Year


